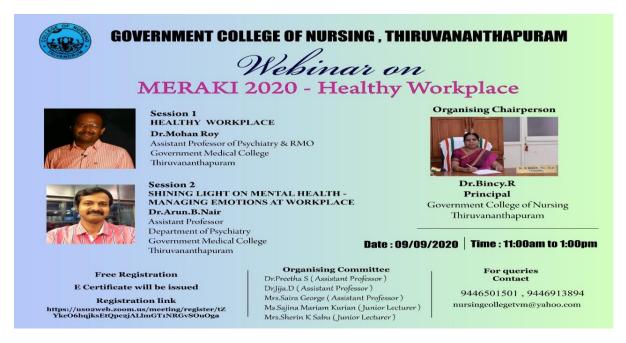
MENTAL HEALTH NURSING DEPARTMENT

Erwadi fire incident occurred on 6 August 2001, when 28 inmates of mental asylum died in the fire. Erwadi Tragedy Commemoration was conducted in association with Department of Psychiatry, Government Medical College. Role play was conducted by BSc nursing students regarding the misconceptions of mental illness and the rights of mentally ill.
