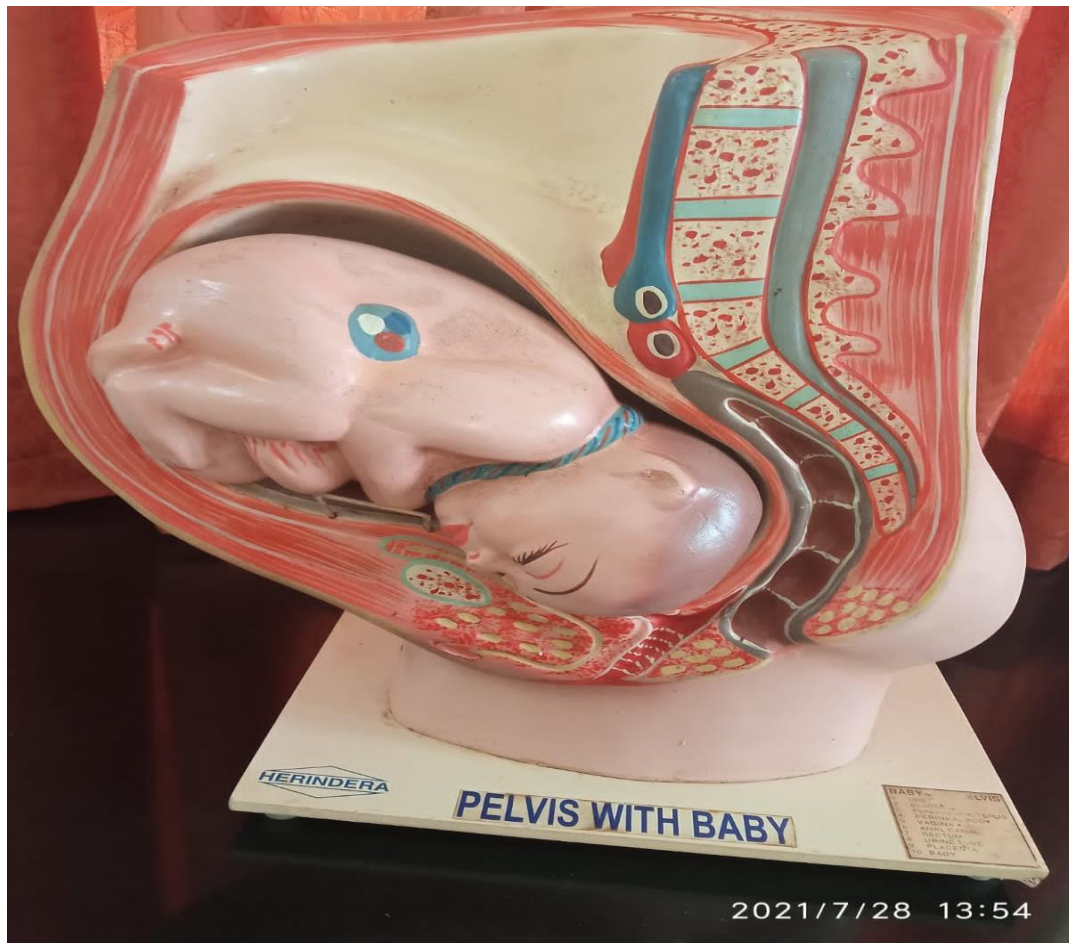

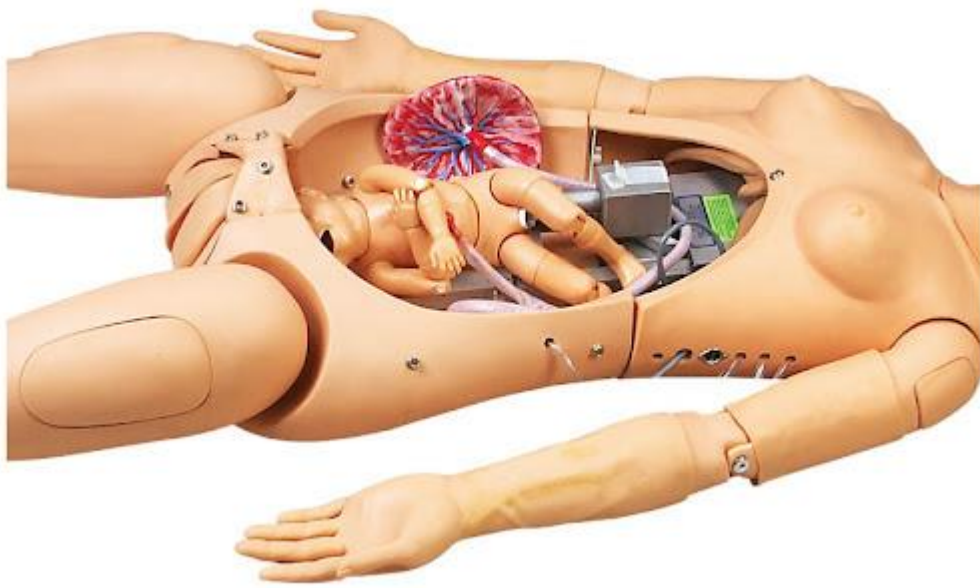
LAB FACILITIES

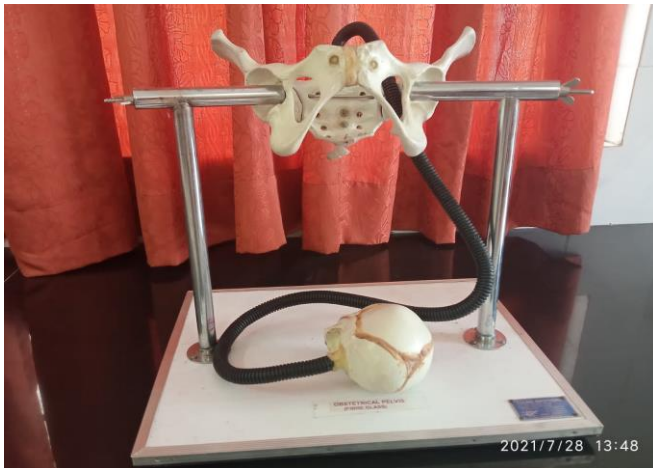

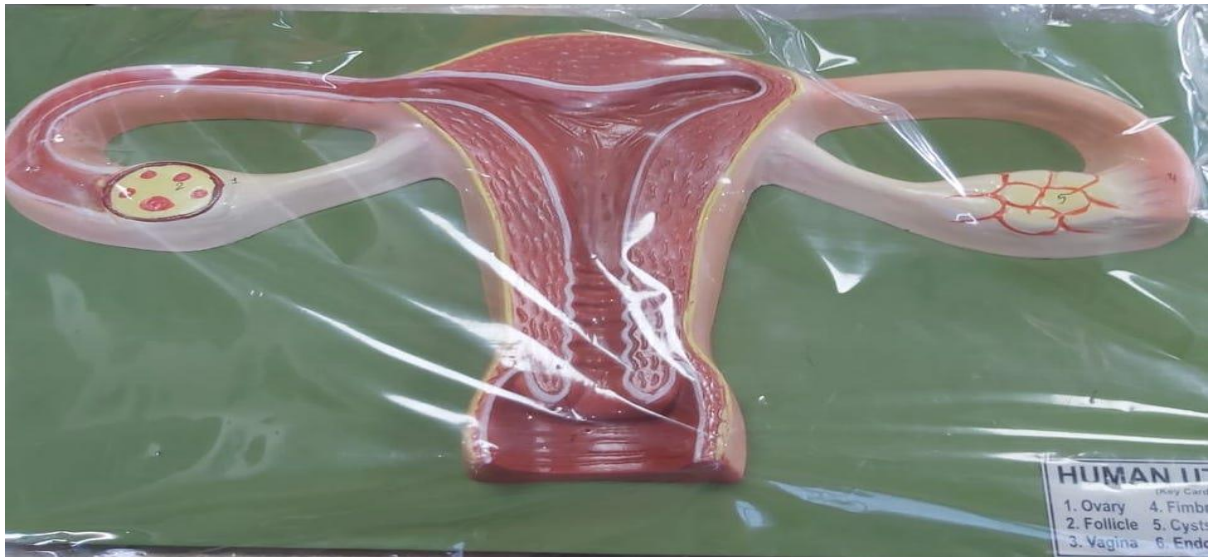
the students to acquire Knowledge & skills in patient care that are to be practiced in clinical settings
